Conditions Notice
Important! Please Read

(1) **Deposit and Payment:** A non-refundable deposit of \$1500.00 per person is required to secure space for this tour. This must accompany the application for processing. Full and final payment is due no later than 60 days prior to departure. After acceptance of booking, if the customer does not pay the balance by the described time, the Society reserves the right to cancel the booking and, in such cases, the deposit will be subject to forfeiture. (See "Cancellation" paragraph below for full refund conditions.) We accept Visa, MC, DiscoverCard or American Express. We are not able to accept any other credit cards. Payment by check or money must be in US funds from a US bank. Payment by wire transfer is subject to additional fees.

After 5/20/2012 payment in full is required to secure space for the land portion of the tour and is due with application. See paragraph (7) 'Cancellation,' below for full cancellation rules. After acceptance of booking, cancellation rules are in effect.

(2) **Important (3 items):** (1) Quoted tour price is based on exchange rate in effect at the time of original quotation (11/25/2011) and is subject to adjustment at time of actual payment; (2) Pricing is based on a minimum of 12 participants including two SIS hosts. (3) "Double Occupancy" rate is subject to availability of a roommate requesting similar accommodations. If a roommate cannot be assigned, reservation will be upgraded to "Single Occupancy" rate and all provisions of this "Conditions Notice" will apply.

(3) **Included:** 9 nights in our select hotels incl. all applicable service charges and local taxes including VAT. Rooms are standard double or twin; full Scottish breakfast each day and 4 dinners, including our welcome and farewell banquets; pre-paid green fees for 7 rounds on listed courses as indicated in the tour itinerary. Ground transportation by luxury coach throughout, including from Dublin Airport* on June 20 and return transfer to Shannon Airport* on June 29;

*Based on participants arriving Dublin by 1:00 pm on June 20 and departing Shannon mid-morning or later on June 29 (exact schedule will be designed to be as accommodating to the group as is reasonable after everyone's flight schedule is available). Additional costs associated with early or late airport arrivals and early or late departures are the responsibility of the participant.

(4) **Not Included:** Airfare, gratuities; passport fees; visa fees; airport taxes; non-specified meals, alcoholic beverages, dinner beverages, caddies, golf carts, personal items such as telephone charges, laundry or any other personal charges you may incur; accident, baggage or trip cancellation/interruption insurance (can be purchased separately); and any other items not specifically mentioned as "included" in the tour itinerary.

(5) **Caddies:** Caddies may be requested but are not guaranteed. In case of late cancellation (less than 24 hours) of a caddy request player may be responsible for payment. Caddies are usually paid in cash on site.

(6) **Cancellation:** Tour begins in Dublin on June 20, 2012. Deposits and payments are non-refundable except as indicated below. Cancellations received between 70 days and 30 days prior to start of tour are subject to forfeiture of deposit plus any non-refundable fees assessed by hotels, golf courses and suppliers. Cancellation within 30 days of departure the total price is forfeitable. **Trip cancellation insurance can mitigate your risk** *.

In the event of cancellation by the Shivas Irons Society all deposits and payments are fully refundable. The Society assumes no other liability for any costs or loss related to such cancellation.

***Note regarding trip cancellation insurance:** To qualify for a pre-existing conditions waiver, many insurance companies require that insurance must be purchased within a specified time period of trip application and deposit payment. If you have such a condition, please consult with the SIS before submitting signed application.

(7) **Responsibility:** The Shivas Irons Society acts only as agent for the hotels, tour operators, sight-seeing companies, transportation services as used in providing the arrangements included in the tour itinerary, and shall not be held liable for any delay, accident, injury, damage or loss incurred by vehicle defect or through any act of any supplier and/or its employees. The Shivas Irons Society shall not be held responsible for any act, error or omission. If, for any reason itinerary or arrangements must be altered, such changes may be made without penalty to The Shivas Irons Society and any additional charges may be collected from the passenger.

(8) **Tax-deductibility (US):** A portion of your fees are a contribution to the Shivas Irons Society, a California non-profit corporation, exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and comparable California legislation, contributions to which are deductible for income tax purposes to the extent provided by law.
